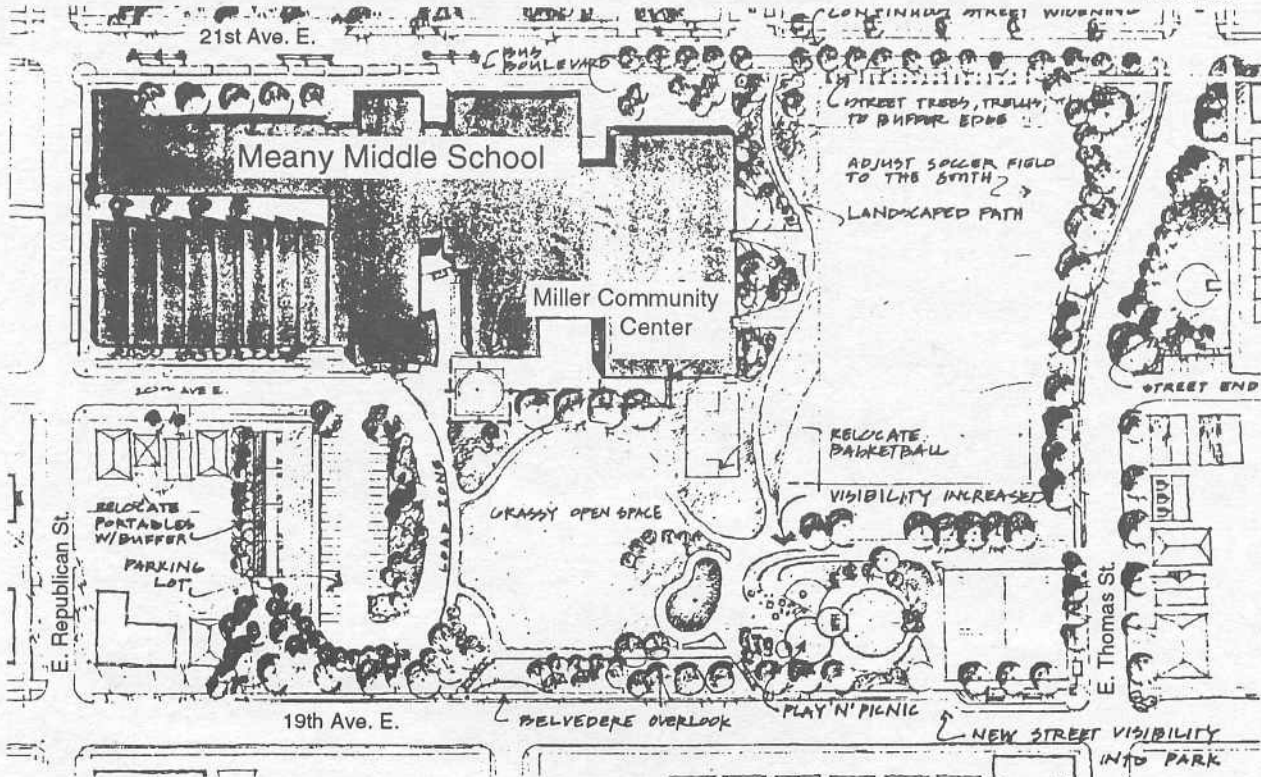

Miller Park: The Dream is Alive

The Miller Parks Dreams Project is complete, providing an exciting new master plan for our park. It helps correct many old problems that have developed over the years, and creates new areas and landscaping for a more diverse and usable park. Some of the less expensive improvements may occur over the next few years, while major construction will probably have to wait until the next Bond Issue.

This article, together with drawings from the new master plan, explains some of the problems with the current park facilities and how they can be improved.

1) **Where is the Community Center?** Many people we surveyed in the neighborhood didn't even realize there was a Community Center. They just thought that the school had some after hours activities. The entrance is tucked way back in a courtyard at the end of a dead-end street which people perceive as the back of the school. The gyms inside are
